**THE MEDITERRANEAN AND ADRIATIC** are known for their glamorous rivieras – stunning coastlines blessed with golden beaches, historic towns and world-class dining. But while Monte Carlo and Dubrovnik deserve their fame, few tourists explore beyond them to the smaller ports and quaint fishing villages that share these voluptuous shores.

#### SANARY-SUR-MER: THE FRENCH RIVIERA AS IT USED TO BE

Traditional blue and white pointus fishing boats and heritage ships floating in the harbor – evidence of the town's still-active fishing fleet. There are the usual historic attractions, local vineyards and fragrant boulangeries you expect in southern France, but surprisingly absent are the crowds that frequent better-known French Riviera cities. This is the authentic Riviera.

A walk through Old Town reveals Roman roots. Enter the Tour Romaine, a 13<sup>th</sup>-century tower, to find Roman amphorae and other archeological treasures salvaged from shipwrecks offshore. (There are advantages to having the

late Jacques Cousteau and other diving pioneers as former residents.) In more recent times, Sanary was a refuge for writers and intellectuals fleeing pre-war Germany, and you'll find commemorative plaques around town indicating places frequented by Thomas Mann and others in the 1930s.

Of course, beaches are the final arbiter of a town's Riviera credentials, and Sanary has several choice options. There's even an underwater trail where snorkelers can explore the underwater ecosystem that so fascinated Jacques Cousteau and his compatriots.



#### KOMIZA: DALMATIAN DELIGHT

Komiza, a small town on Dalmatia's most remote populated island, is the perfect place to find an authentic Croatian experience. Like Sanary-sur-Mer it's a traditional fishing village, but the resemblance doesn't end there.

Traditional fishing boats ply Komiza's waters too, only here they're known as gajeta falkuša. Komiza's museum is in a Venetian tower as opposed to Sanary's Romanesque tower. Both have signature beaches and neighboring vineyards that create praise-worthy wines. And while Sanary sheltered Germany's oppressed, Komiza sheltered resistance leader Josip Broz Tito (later President of

#### PLAN YOUR ESCAPE

Brightly colored fishing boats scoot out of the way as you enter the harbor at Sanary-sur-Mer. There's not a large cruise ship in sight, and a quick tender ride takes you right to the heart of Old Town where historic buildings alternate with boulangeries. It's a place only small ships like Windstar's fleet can go – like Komiza. Except in Komiza we're the only large or small cruise line, giving you easier access to key sights like the Blue Cave and Mount Hum.



Yugoslavia) in late 1943. Not such a strange coincidence, really. After all, it's hard to imagine a finer place to take refuge than these lovely and authentic Riviera towns.

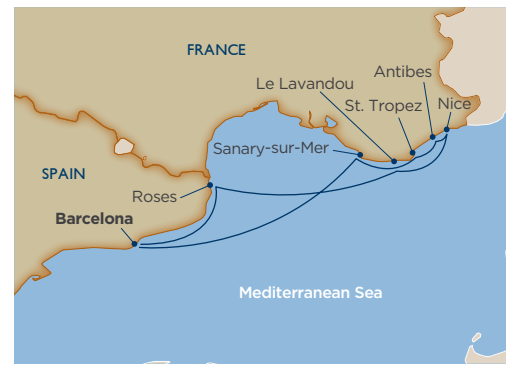

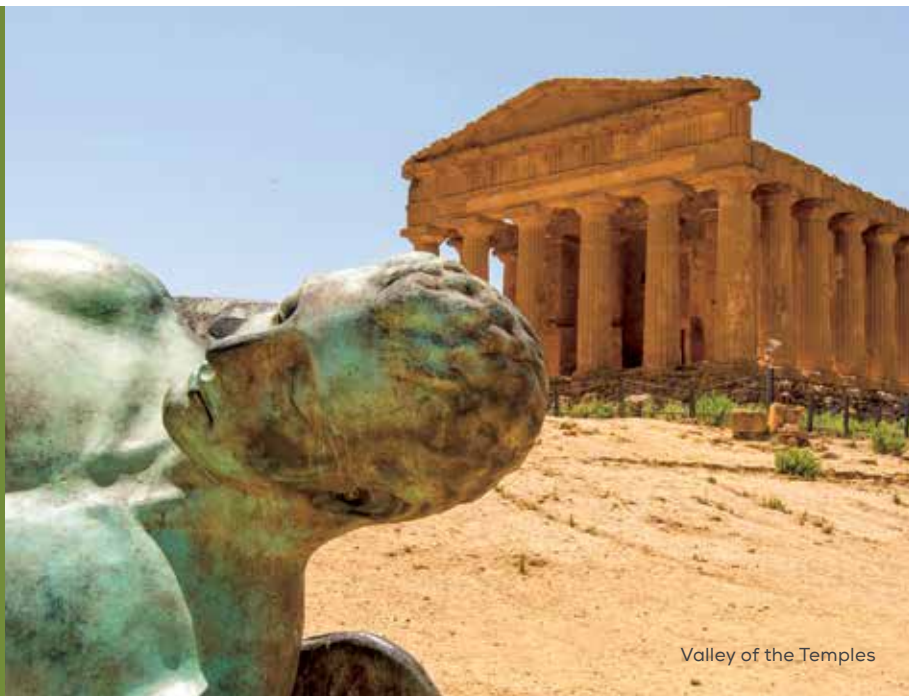

**MOST VISITORS EXPLORE WESTERN EUROPE** and the Mediterranean before considering Northern Europe. And even when they get to Northern Europe they usually focus on major cities, leaving magical places like Portrush and Mariehamn undiscovered.

### PORTRUSH, NORTHERN IRELAND: LAND OF GIANTS

Your first reaction to the Giant's Causeway is disbelief. Your second is awe. And your third may be an almost irresistible urge to play hopscotch on the hexagonal steps that spread before you like some Temple of Doom artifact.

According to legend, the giant Finn McCool threw a handful of the Antrim Coast into the sea so he could cross to Scotland and conquer the giant Benandonner. Geologists claim the 40,000 interlocking basalt columns formed during volcanic eruptions more than 60 million years ago. But whether you believe in

giants or geology, this UNESCO World Heritage Site is an amazing sight, set in a coastline studded with castles, Blue Flag beaches, and the nine famous deep green glens of Antrim.

### MARIEHAMN, ALAND ISLANDS, FINLAND: PORT OF THE LAST WINDJAMMERS

The Aland Islands have a unique multicultural identity borne of their colorful past, and a short tour of the main island brings it all into focus. A medieval castle, Kastelholm, dates to the late 14<sup>th</sup> century

when this was the center of the Swedish Kingdom. Not far away are the ruins of Bomarsund Fortress, begun in 1830 as a way for Russia to strengthen this part of its western frontier. And also nearby, the Jan Karlsgården Open-Air Museum gives visitors an idea of what life may have been like during the late 1800s not long before the Russian Revolution and its fallout gave a third country, Finland, sovereignty.

During this latter period, the islands became known for shipbuilding and were home to the world's largest fleet of windjammer sailing ships — a proud maritime heritage that lives on in Mariehamn's Maritime

### MEMORABLE MUSEUMS

*The four-masted Pommern is the last windjammer in the world still in its original condition and you can go aboard this floating exhibit when you visit Mariehamn's popular Maritime Museum. Or if you're in Portrush, divide your time between the Giant's Causeway and its Visitor Center, whose award-winning architecture cleverly echoes the natural feature. Both Star Pride and Star Breeze call at these two ports in 2019.*
